Report to Operating Record

Pursuant with the requirements of 40CFR257.80(b)(7)(c), DTE Energy has reviewed the fugitive dust management activities, the record of any citizen fugitive dust complaints, and corrective actions taken to control fugitive dust.

During the operating period of October 2015 thru February 2016, no exceptions to the fugitive dust management plan were noted, no citizen fugitive dust complaints were received, and no corrective actions beyond daily operational control activities were required to control fugitive dust as the Sibley Quarry Landfill.
